

## **Journal of Consumer Protection and Food Security (JVL)**

### **Instructions for authors – types of papers**

The JVL welcomes high quality research papers presenting novel data in the fields of food, feed and commodities as well as crop protection products, veterinary drugs, genetic engineering and consumer protection. New data in these areas are published as RESEARCH ARTICLES, SHORT COMMUNICATIONS and METHODS. Research papers will be accepted that have not been published previously. The JVL also publishes REVIEW ARTICLES as well as ANNOUNCEMENTS AND REPORTS, EVENTS AND NEWS and OPINIONS. All submissions to the JVL undergo an initial editorial review. Those research papers selected as suitable for the JVL are peer-reviewed.

The general format of all manuscript types is identical (except for review articles). The selection is based on the content of the manuscript and will be decided by the editorial office. However, authors are invited to select an appropriate type of paper and draft the manuscript according to the listed criteria. Due to limited space in the JVL all manuscript types are also limited in terms of length.

*General manuscript format:* Manuscript sections should be presented in the following order: Title page with abstract and keywords, Introduction, Material and Methods (except for Short Communication), Results (and) Discussion, Conclusions, Acknowledgment, References, Tables, Figure legends and Figures.

Important: Data that is not essential for understanding the content of the paper should be included only as supplementary data.

RESEARCH ARTICLES (original research, peer-reviewed) generally contain extensive advances and/or analyses:

- Maximal length is 28,000 characters including space characters and references but without tables and figures.
- Abstract not more than 250 words (self-explanatory and without abbreviations)
- Reference list with maximal 50 citations.

SHORT COMMUNICATIONS (original research, peer-reviewed) are concise and independent short reports representing significant contributions:

- Maximal length is 14,000 characters including space characters, tables, figures and references.
- Abstract not more than 150 words (self-explanatory and without abbreviations)
- Reference list with maximal 10 citations.
- No sub-structures (sub-headings)
- Data about materials and methods is included as supplementary data

METHODS (original research, peer-reviewed) are manuscript focussing on novel methodology:

- Maximal length is 21,000 characters including space characters and references but without tables and figures.
- Abstract not more than 150 words (self-explanatory and without abbreviations)

REVIEW ARTICLES (peer-reviewed) including meta-analyses are critical evaluations of material that has already been published:

- Maximal length is 35,000 characters including space characters and references but without tables and figures.
- Abstract not more than 250 words (self-explanatory and without abbreviations)
- Appropriate chapter structure
- No supplementary data

OPINIONS (not peer-reviewed) are concise commentary articles with reference to recent occasions and developments.

ANNOUNCEMENTS AND REPORTS (not peer-reviewed) are contributions about administrative surveillance or other administrative activities.

EVENTS AND NEWS (not peer-reviewed) are various contributions like event information, book reviews etc.
